



## P3 Curriculum News

Term: 3 Dates: Jan — Mar 2019

#### Literacy and English

**Reading** – We will continue to focus on tools for reading and Bloom's questioning to enhance children's understanding of class fiction texts. Reciprocal reading strategies such as predicting, questioning and summarising will continue to be built on.

Writing - The children will be using different genre of writing to continue developing their writing skills. Pupils have set their own targets to work on throughout the term.

**Spelling** – The children will learn one new spelling sound or rhyming pattern each week. They will practise spelling words containing this sound, as well as other common and tricky words.

**Talking and Listening** – We will continue to work on our listening and talking skills by developing them through various activities. Skills will be further enhanced through the use of presentations and reciting our Scottish poetry.

## Numeracy & Mathematics



- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Data and Analysis
- Mental maths will focus on, develop and enhance the learning of the above concepts.

#### Social Studies and I.C.T.

- Our topics this term are Scotland followed by Dinosaurs.
- Word processing skills and topic related activities. Opportunities will also be available in ICT to support class literacy and numeracy topics.

## Health & Wellbeing includes Physical Education

PE\_ - P.E. sessions will take place on a **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Throughout January we will develop co-ordination and timing through Scottish Dance. In February and March we will be working on Gymnastics as well as working with an SFA coach on ball skills.

Please ensure that children have **full** gym kit — shorts, t-shirt and soft shoes. Pupils **must** have long hair tied back and all jewellery **must** be removed. ## Health & Wellbeing

Throughout this term we will be looking at how and why the body needs energy to function and why physical activity is necessary for positive health and wellbeing.

## Expressive Arts

 ${f Drama}$  — Drama opportunities will take place across the curriculum allowing children to develop movement, expression, and improvisation skills especially in preparation for our class assembly.

Art and Design — Art will largely be linked with our Scotland topic. There is a huge array of activities that will develop our knowledge of drawing, pattern, collage and the use of colour.
